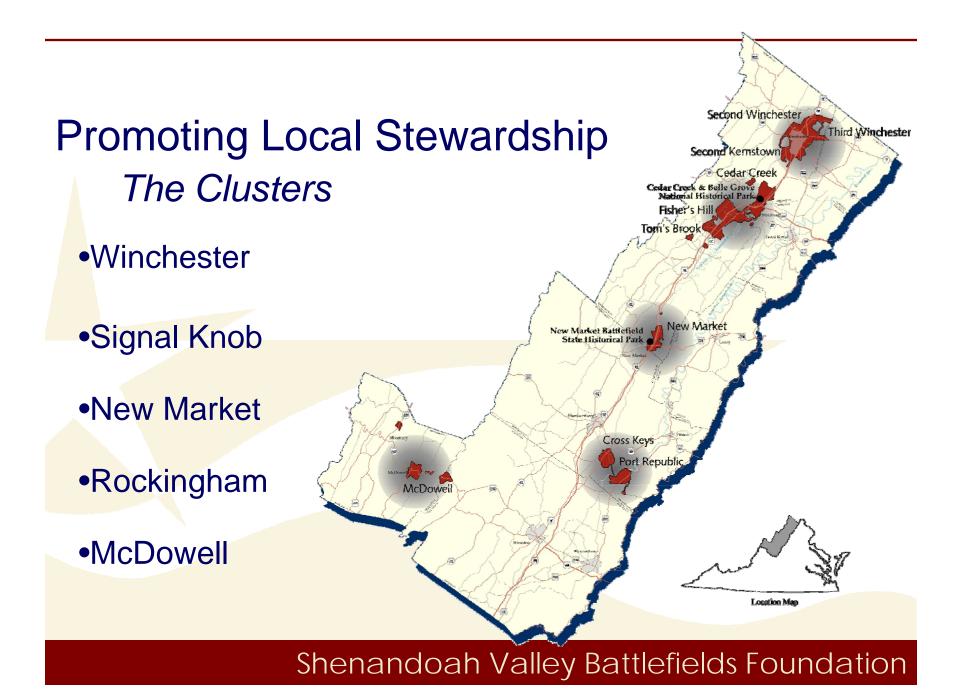


#### Management & Partnerships:

- Implementing the Management Plan
- \$657,000 granted
- \$2.75 million leveraged in projects





#### Cluster/Partner Roles

- Collaborate to create a high-quality, unique visitor experience in the cluster
- Identify temporary and permanent sites for Civil War orientation centers and get them started
- Identify and establish driving tour routes to battlefields and other Civil War sites
- Enhance existing sites and open new ones as local interest and funding allow

- Assist the SVBF in securing additional funding for cluster and District-wide projects

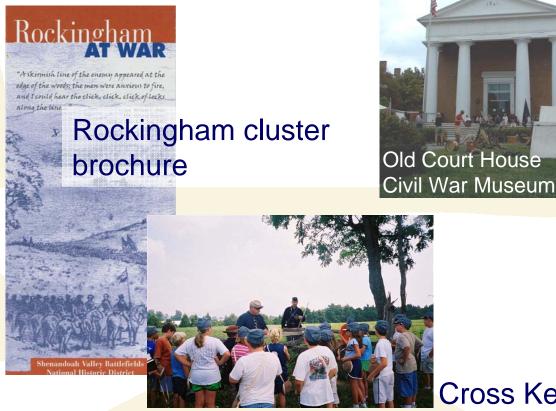
