## Code of Virginia, Title 67 Summary: Energy Policy & Objectives

- Ensure availability of reliable energy reasonable costs
- Establish sufficient infrastructure
- Use resources efficiently & facilitate conservation
- Facilitate development of Virginia's low cost resources, including clean coal and natural gas
- Facilitate development of less polluting energy sources
- Foster energy R&D
- Address environmental protection with energy facilities


## Virginia Energy Plan Goals

- Increase energy independence
  - 40% reduction in rate of energy growth base case
  - 20% increase in in-state energy production base case
- Expand consumer energy education
  - Overcome barriers to consumer action
- Climate change
  - 2000 GHG emission levels by 2025;  $\approx$  30% from BAU
- R & D / economic development
  - Alternate fuels, nuclear technologies, coastal energy, carbon capture & storage




## Goal 1 – Reduce Energy Consumption





## Goal 1 – Increase Energy Production





#### • Increase efficiency incentives

- Federal income tax incentives expanded in ARRA
- Two October Energy Star state sales tax holidays
- \$15 million State Energy Program ARRA rebates

#### • Utility efficiency programs

- 2008 natural gas conservation/decoupling Virginia Natural Gas and Columbia Gas of Virginia
- 2009 electric utility level playing field between returns for efficiency & generation Dominion portfolio filed with SCC
- Electric cooperatives demand response and conservation programs
- \$7 million ARRA to expand utility Energy Star equipment rebates
- Dominion, coops, municipal smart grid investments



- Weatherization Assistance Program
  - Double formula funding
  - \$94 million ARRA
- Policies to improve building stock
  - 2009 model code implementation; 2012 planning
  - VHEN builder and energy auditor training
  - Home Builders Association Earth Craft Homes
  - Executive Order 82 New State LEED/Green Globes



- Residential, commercial, industrial consumers
  - Expanded federal income tax credits
  - \$15 million State Energy Program ARRA efficiency rebates
  - SE industrial efficiency program
- Deploy new technologies
  - \$5 million State Energy Program ARRA for new jobs in clean energy technology commercialization



#### Lead by example

- Executive Order 82 25% goal by 2012; Energy savings performance contracts; demand response; natural gas and heating oil purchasing; energy manager training; fleet efficiency standards
- Local government climate and sustainability plans; EECBG ARRA efficiency investments

#### • Transportation systems

- Increased transit funding Norfolk light rail construction; Dulles Metro expansion
- Northern Virginia HOT lanes
- Executive Order 82 2% biodiesel after July 1, 2010
- Multi-modal state transportation plan



#### Expanded renewable production

- Expanded RPS
- VCERC offshore wind R&D
- DEQ permit by rule for small renewable systems
- \$38 million State Energy Program ARRA funding for solar/wind
- RPS excess production payments
- New interconnection standards and right of way access
- Highland New Wind under construction; expanded landfill gas generation

#### • Energy infrastructure investments

- Electric transmission and distribution lines
- HRX natural gas pipeline crossing
- MMS OSC oil and gas lease sale 220
- Biofuels production and pipeline shipment



- Expanded energy education
  - SCC Consumer Education Plan



- Energy and environment
  - Governor's Commission on Climate Change
  - No state GHG reporting; EPA rule development
  - Land use transportation standards
    - New secondary road standards for compact development
    - High growth localities
      - Urban development areas
      - Transportation impact fees
      - Transportation service districts
    - CTB transportation and land use performance measures
- SW VA carbon capture and storage test



- Reliable investments in energy RD&D
  - Tobacco Commission RD&D investments
    - \$40 million in 5 energy technology centers
    - Up to \$100 million in energy commercialization deployment
  - VCERC investments algae and offshore wind
  - VT Center for Coal and Energy Research
  - State university internal fund investments
  - CIT SBIR/STTR assistance
  - Difficulties in matching federal funds



- Interagency Task Force for Energy Project Recruitment
- \$5 million State Energy Program ARRA planned for new jobs in clean energy businesses
- Nuclear support AREVA, Babcock & Wilcox, Northrop Grumman
  - Lynchburg and Campbell County facilities
  - Newport News reactor component manufacturing
- Coal and Energy Commission uranium mining study
