





CASE STUDY #1

- \$3.5 Million Investment
- Payback in > 3 Years
- Processed Wood Replaces 1.2 Million Gallons of Propane Per Year
- Trucks off Road = 22,000 Gallons of Diesel Per Year Saved
- Carbon Neutral

Residential School Installation



Energy Provided by Oil Fired Boilers

- Consumption Per Year =
 - 181,199 Gallons #2 Fuel Oil
- Cost \$616,076 Projected (\$3.40/Gallon Average)
- Fuel Savings with Wood Fuel
 - \$379,226

Comparative Fuel Value

- Processed Wood Fuel Expressed in Gallons of #2
 Fuel Oil =
 - \$1.31/Gallon

Major Obstacle

- High Cost of Equipment
 - \$2.7 Million est.

Home Heating



In Germany, 20% of All Heating is Done with Wood Pellets (Usually Involves Hot Water as Well)

- **Englander Stove Works**
 - Headquartered in Lynchburg, VA
 - 30,000 Stoves Manufactured in 2008
 - Average Retail Cost = \$1300
 - Average Pellet Consumption with an Englander Stove = 4 Tons
 - Will Eliminate the Need for 13,830,00 Gallons of **Heating Oil**
 - Will Likely Save the Consumer Money
 - Less than 1% Ash
 - No Environmental Issues
 - **Carbon Neutral**
