### Offenses Leading to License Suspension-Revocation

- Driving Under Influence
- Reckless Driving, Racing, etc.
- Driving on Suspended License
- Failure to Pay Court Fines and Costs
- Failure to Pay Child Support

### Drive-To-Work Eligibility Guidelines

1. Application and initial interview
2. Gross income less than twice the federal poverty level or program referral
3. A job or other source of funds to pay costs to DMV, past due fines, etc.
4. Retainer letter and \$100.00 administrative fee when case is accepted
