

VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUADS RECEIVE RECRUITMENT TRAILER



Chief Edwards has advised that a new EMS Recruitment Trailer has been delivered to the Volunteer Rescue Squads. The 14 foot trailer was designed by several of our Volunteer EMS members. Funding for the trailer came from a Rescue Squad Assistance Fund Grant and the Council of Virginia Beach Volunteer Rescue Squads, Inc. The Volunteer Rescue Squad Recruitment Trailer is outfitted with audio-visual equipment and LCD Screens to

show various EMS Recruitment and public awareness videos. In addition, marketing materials, tabletop display boards and a fold-up EMS Event Booth are stored inside. When not set up at an event, it is a rolling billboard for EMS, and features colorful graphics on the outside to promote volunteerism, community service, and all 10 volunteer rescue squads. Chief Edwards said “This project shows the continued strength of our volunteers, not only for handling more than 36,000 calls annually, but also by using teamwork, they have accomplished a considerable undertaking that will help the entire EMS system.” The new EMS Recruitment Trailer’s schedule of appearances is filling up fast – look for it a future event!
