JCOTS met on Tuesday, November 18, 2014 to continue the discussion of issues raised by SB 599 (2014) related to cloud computing and student data. Staff provided brief follow-up on issues raised at prior meetings regarding the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA), database breach law as may or may not apply in educational settings, and other related issues. JCOTS received presentations relating to use of student data from the Virginia Department of Education, Fairfax County Public Schools, and Henrico County Public Schools. Copies of these presentations are available on the JCOTS website.

After the discussions related to student data privacy concluded, Senator John Watkins provided an overview of the identity management legislation that the Identity Management Advisory Committee had been working on during the Interim. A copy of the draft legislation is available on the JCOTS website. The committee will be asked to vote as to whether to recommend the legislation to the 2015 Session of the General Assembly at the December JCOTS meeting.
