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Goals







- Strengthen academic achievement, especially in the areas of science, technology, engineering and math. (STEM)

 - Technology tools




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

An "equal opportunity" environment where youth can access the tools, mentors, technology and programs they need to compete in a skilled and educated workforce.



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


- First "Computer Clubhouse" launched in 1999



 - > 30,000 individual users, both adult and children



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
