

SUMMARY

Virginia Public Procurement Act; use of competitive sealed bidding or competitive negotiation for the procurement of goods, certain services, and insurance. Removes the requirement that a determination be made in advance by a public body and set forth in writing that competitive sealed bidding for goods, services, or insurance is either not practicable or not fiscally advantageous to the public in order for such goods, services, or insurance to be procured by competitive negotiation.
