Clients' Protection Fund	§ 54.1-3913.1	July 1, 2015	This section establishes the Fund and fees as a special fund under the Virginia State Bar (Chapter 807, 2007).
Tax credit for processing recyclable materials	§ 58.1-439.7	January 1, 2015	This section provides a tax credit for purchase of machinery and equipment for processing recyclable materials (Chapter 529, 2007).
Energy Star or WaterSense products	§ 58.1-609.1	July 1, 2012	Chapters 176 and 817, 2007, provide a sales tax exemption for these products sold during a certain period during the year.

Chapters 784 and 826, 2010, provide an exemption for computer equipment and software for use in data centers creating at least 50 jobs (subdivision 18).
