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Coal Employment and Production Incentive Tax Credit	§ 58.1-433.1	July 1, 2016	This credit expires for persons with an economic interest in coal (Chapter 294, 2011).
Coalfield employment enhancement tax credit	§ 58.1-439.2	January 1, 2017	This sections allows a per ton tax credit based on seam thickness (Chapters 309 and 649, 2012).
Tax credit for processing recyclable materials	§ 58.1-439.7	January 1, 2015	This section provides a tax credit for purchase of machinery and equipment for processing recyclable materials (Chapter 529, 2007).
Neighborhood Assistance Act Tax Credit	§ 58.1-439.20	July 1, 2028	This section authorizes tax credits for certain programs (Chapter 716, 2013).
Energy Star or WaterSense products	§ 58.1-609.1	July 1, 2017	Chapter 597, 2012, provide a sales tax exemption for these products sold during a certain period during the year.
Commercial and Industrial Exemptions to Retail Sales and Use Tax	§ 58.1-609.3	July 1, 2016	Chapter 183, 2011, provides an exemption for machinery, tools and equipment used in drilling for natural gas or oil (subdivision 12).
