What is SWaM?

Supplier Diversity Strengthens the Commonwealth

- SWaM, acronym for <u>S</u>mall, <u>W</u>omen-owned, <u>a</u>nd <u>M</u>inority-owned businesses
- ➤ The **SWaM** Program is the state initiative to develop and strengthen purchasing and procurement opportunities for Small, Women-owned, and Minority-owned Businesses
- To participate in the SWaM Program, businesses must be certified



What is DBE?

Supplier Diversity Strengthens the Commonwealth

- ▶ DBE, acronym for <u>D</u>isadvantaged <u>B</u>usiness <u>E</u>nterprise Program. The DBE Program is a federal certification program for businesses interesting in federally-funded transportation contracts
- To participate in the DBE Program, businesses must be certified



- Conducting on-site interviews to evaluate the capabilities and capacities of businesses that are seeking state procurement opportunities
- Providing management and technical assistance to businesses in pursuit of procurement opportunities with the Commonwealth of Virginia, federal agencies, or military installations





Supplier Diversity Strengthens the Commonwealth

- ➤ Increased the number of certified businesses nearly 400%, from 4,965 in FY06 to 17,346 in FY10
- Established business connection offices in Northern, Central, Southeastern, and Southwestern regions of Virginia





Supplier Diversity Strengthens the Commonwealth

- ➤ Increased the number of contracts awarded to certified businesses by 20% annually since Fiscal Year 2006
- ➤ Streamlined the SWaM certification process with a more user-friendly, web-based, application and certification tracking system
