In addition, JCOTS will host William & Mary students as summer interns, providing them with direct experience in public policy and valuable insights into the legislative process. "This partnership with JCOTS underscores William & Mary's commitment to innovative research that benefits the communities around us," said W&M Provost and Chief Academic Officer Peggy Agouris. "In alignment with the university's recent designation as an R1 institution, collaborating with JCOTS will provide incredible opportunities for students to engage in hands-on experiential learning, contribute to cutting-edge projects and shape the future of their industries."

As a key feature of the partnership, JCOTS will also host a research symposium on William & Mary's campus in the spring of 2026. The symposium will bring together legislators, scholars, students, and subject matter experts to explore emerging technology trends and foster collaborative dialogue.
