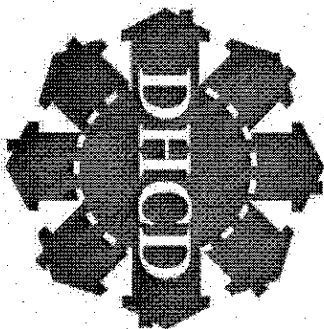

Role in Housing

- ❖ Expanding homeownership options.
- ❖ Addressing gaps in affordable housing.
- ❖ Decreasing the level of substandard housing.
- ❖ Building the capacity of not-for-profit housing developers.
- ❖ Intervening to prevent homelessness.
- ❖ Providing shelter and services to homeless individuals and families.

Role in Community and Economic Development

- ❖ Revitalization of distressed areas.
- ❖ Support for community economic development.
- ❖ Fostering entrepreneurship.
- ❖ Development of community infrastructure.
- ❖ Building more livable communities.
- ❖ Building the capacity of community organizations.

Role in Building and Fire Regulation

- ❖ Development of state building and fire codes, including the Uniform Statewide Building Code (USBC) and State Fire Prevention Code (SFPC).
- ❖ Fostering the re-use of older buildings through the new Virginia Rehabilitation Code.
- ❖ Striving to achieve uniformity in the implementation of the state building and fire codes through training, technical assistance and the appeals process.
- ❖ Regulation of the manufactured housing industry.
- ❖ Directly responsible for fire safety in state-owned buildings and in localities without a local fire marshal.

Additional Roles . . .

- ❖ Supporting regional approaches.
- ❖ Reviewing inter-local agreements and boundary adjustments.
- ❖ Serving as a pass-through organization for state funding to agency related entities:
 - Southeast Rural Community Assistance Project
 - Center for Rural Virginia
 - Planning District Commissions

DHCD and VHDA

- ❖ DHCD and VHDA work together to meet the housing needs of Virginians.
- ❖ The structure of existing state and federal low-income housing tax credits programs requires coordination between the two agencies.
- ❖ VHDA is a major source of finance for a variety of housing options serving low- and moderate-income Virginians.
- ❖ DHCD focuses on areas of particular or specialized housing needs, including lower-income families and households that may not qualify for some VHDA programs.

DHCD and VHDA

- ❖ VHDA and DHCD share responsibilities for various aspects of housing program design and operation.
- ❖ DHCD provides guidance on policies and programs using federal and state funds, while VHDA performs the financial transactions and monitoring.
- ❖ Cross-cutting membership requirements for the boards.
- ❖ Reporting on programs that involve both agencies.
- ❖ The agencies operate within an environment in which housing is a critical component of broader efforts intended to enhance the overall well-being of Virginia's communities.



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
